

POSSESSION OF UNEXPLAINED PROPERTY

Section 12, Prevention of Corruption Act (Chapter 131)



Any public officer or person who has previously been a public officer living a lifestyle that is inconsistent with their current or past income

Or

possessing or controlling wealth or property that is disproportionate to their current or past income



Failure to explain how the wealth was acquired, is an **Offence under Section 12** of the Prevention of Corruption Act (Chapter 131)



If found guilty,
the penalty is a fine of **\$30,000.00** and **imprisonment for 7 years**



"Public officer" includes those who work in public bodies.
